## Payment Policy Updates: Services Not Reimbursed

MVP Health Care ${ }^{\circledR}$ (MVP) is consistent in following Medicare guidelines and Claims EXT edits for services that are not reimbursed distinctly and separately. Effective 9/1/2019, MVP will not reimburse separately for the services that fall under the categories listed below. These services are inclusive in other payments made by MVP. Radiology Payment Policy - Effective 9/1/2019 Primary Care Physicians, Physician Assistants and Nurse Practitioners reading diagnostic images require an overread of the image by a Radiologist or a specialist physician reviewing the image within the scope of their specialty. Physician specialists are required to have the image overread by a radiologist if the imaging is outside the scope of their practice. MVP reimburses for only one reading of a diagnostic radiology test. Duplicate readings are not eligible for reimbursement.
