Comprehensive Diabetes Care (CDC): Retinal Exam Using Funduscopic Photography

MVP members 18–75 years of age with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes who have a retinal or dilated eye exam performed in the current measurement year. The use of funduscopic cameras in primary care offices provides the opportunity to close retinal eye exam gaps in care for members who do not routinely see an eye care specialist.

Using the funduscopic cameras, primary care providers (PCP) can take images of patients' eyes, without dilation, and send them to an eye care specialist for review and interpretation.

Guidelines for Provider Billing and Reimbursement

Using CPT-CAT Il codes is necessary to delineate who interpreted the eye exam and the results:

- CPT-CAT II 2022F: Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed-with evidence of retinopathy (DM)
- CPT-CAT II 2023F: Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed- without evidence of retinopathy (DM)

Use other CPT-CAT ll codes (2024F, 2025F, 2026F, 2033F) as appropriate.

To ensure the member's gap is successfully closed, please use the following coding information:

Using the Welch Allyn RetinaVue Program and RetinaVue Retina Specialist Network

PCP group bills the global codes 92250 and 2022F or 2023F;

OR

PCP group bills the global code 92250, but with the specialist rendering provider. Specialist must be linked to the PCP group's taxpayer identification number.

Using the Welch Allyn RetinaVue Program without the RetinaVue Retina Specialist Network

PCP group bills the global codes 92250 and 2022F or 2023F. Specialist bills PCP group for agreed upon payment;

OR

PCP group bills for the technical component (92250 TC) and specialist bills separately for the professional component (92250 26).

Using Another Camera

PCP group bills the global codes 92250, and 2022F or 2023F accordingly. Specialist bills PCP group for agreed upon payment;

OR

PCP group bills for the technical component (92250 TC) and specialist bills separately for the professional component (92250 26).
