



Follow-up Care After an Emergency Room Visit

No one wants to take a trip to the Emergency Room (ER). But if you do go, it is important that you follow up with your doctor after you are discharged so they can best treat you and help to prevent future visits.

Whether your ER visit was due to a physical or behavioral health reason, you should talk to your doctor about:

- Why you went to the ER
- What happened during your visit
- The results of any tests or blood work, and what the results mean for you
- New medications or changes to your medications, and are you taking them correctly
- Any other concerns or ask questions, especially if it's been a while since your last visit



If you cannot see your doctor in-person, a telemedicine visit may be an option. A telemedicine visit allows you to talk to your doctor over the phone or online.

2021 Vaccine Schedules Available

Vaccinations for Adults

Vaccines aren't just for kids. Staying up to date with vaccines can help protect you from harmful diseases too. Based on your age, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that adults receive the following vaccinations:

- *Pneumonia Vaccine*—protects against pneumococcal disease, a bacterial infection that can lead to serious health conditions such as pneumonia and meningitis.
- *Zoster Vaccine*—protects against the shingles, a virus that can cause a very painful rash and blisters on your body.
- *Tdap (or Td) Vaccine*—protects against three very serious diseases that can lead to death: Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis.
- *Influenza (Flu) Vaccine*—annual vaccine that protects against seasonal flu.

Visit **cdc.gov/vaccines** and select *Adults (19 and older)* to review the 2021 vaccine schedule and talk to your doctor to see if you are due for any of these vaccines.

Childhood Vaccinations

Babies are born with immune systems that can fight most germs, but there are some deadly diseases they can't handle. That's why they need vaccines to strengthen their immune system. As your child gets older, routine vaccines continue to help protect them from harmful diseases such as measles, pneumonia, and human papillomavirus (HPV).

Visit **cdc.gov/vaccines** and select *Children (Birth to 18)* to review the 2021 vaccine schedule and talk to your child's doctor about any vaccinations they may be due for.

Prescription Medication Reminder

It is very important that you take any medications exactly as they have been prescribed by your doctor for them to best help you.

If you have been prescribed a new medication, or if your medication has changed, make sure you understand:

- When to take the medication
- How much to take
- How to take them (i.e., with or without water or food)
- How long to take them

Once you've started taking prescribed medication(s), if you have any concerns or experience any side effects, call the doctor who prescribed it right away.

2. Create an account.

All members 18 and older can create their own Gia account. If registering via the Gia app, launch the app, select *Create New Account*, and follow the prompts.

If registering via **GoAskGia.com**, complete the required fields, and follow the additional prompts.

Have your MVP Member ID card handy!



You'll be asked to provide basic information, such as your name and email, date of birth, and MVP Subscriber or Member ID. Once your health insurance information is verified, your account will be created.

Note: Through Gia's *Family Consult* feature, you can start a visit for any covered dependents under the age of 18.

Parents/guardians of Child Health Plus members, who are not MVP members themselves, can use the *Tap to Connect Now* feature to access services for their child.
