Eye Exam for Patients with Diabetes

Measure Description

Men and women 18–75 years of age with Diabetes (Type 1 or Type 2) who had retinal screening or monitoring for diabetic retinal disease in 2021 or 2022.

Any of the following meet criteria:

- A retinal or dilated eye exam by an optometrist or ophthalmologist in 2022
- A negative retinal or dilated exam (negative for retinopathy) by an optometrist or ophthalmologist in 2021
- Bilateral eye enucleation (removal of both eyes) anytime during the MVP member’s history through December 31, 2022.

Any of the following meet criteria during 2022.

- ★ Utilize the monthly Gaps in Care (GIC) Report for a list of MVP members and screenings still needed.
- ★ Consider using alerts or flags within the Electronic Medical Record (EMR) for screening tests.
- ★ Discuss the importance of early detection and encourage screening and refer annually.
- ★ Document preventive care in the medical record and indicate the specific date and results.
- ★ Document medical and surgical history in the medical record and include dates.
- ★ Submit all exam results to your local Regional Health Information Organization (RHIO).
- ★ Use correct diagnosis and procedure codes and submit claims and encounter data in a timely manner.
- ★ Consider the use of a retinal imaging device in your practice. Results must be interpreted by an optometrist or ophthalmologist.
- ★ Stock patient areas and exam rooms with screening educational materials such as those found at:
 - [cdc.gov](https://www.cdc.gov)
 - mvphealthcare.com/HealthandWellness
- ★ Order and schedule eye exam appointments before the patient leaves the office. Have a list of facilities available to share with patients.
- ★ Provide patients with an *Eye Care Consultation for Diabetic Patients* form to bring to their appointment to ensure the results of the exam are sent to you. To download the form, visit mvphealthcare.com/Providers and select *Forms*, then *Patient Forms*.
- ★ Your patient may have had a retinal eye exam prior to their enrollment with MVP. The patient will have an open gap in care for this measure until medical record documentation is submitted to MVP. Please refer to your Gaps in Care Report for instructions about how to submit medical records to MVP to close gaps in care.
