

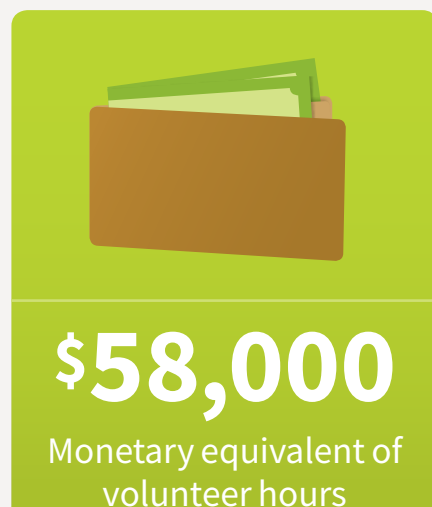
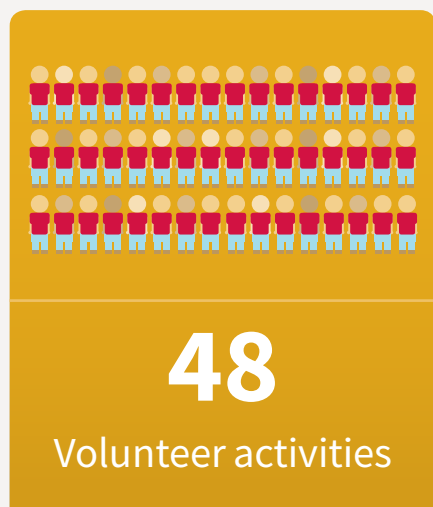
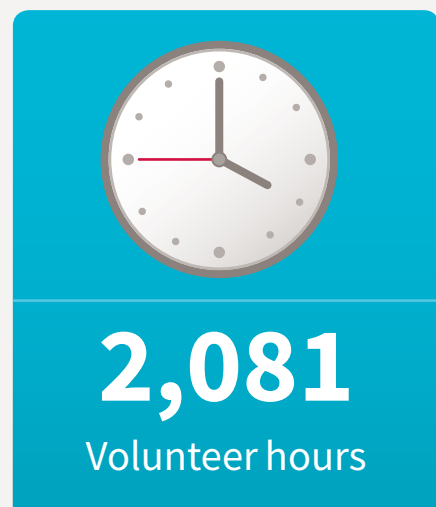
Creating Healthier Communities

MVP employees helped to clean up **100+ acres** at Vale Park in Schenectady.

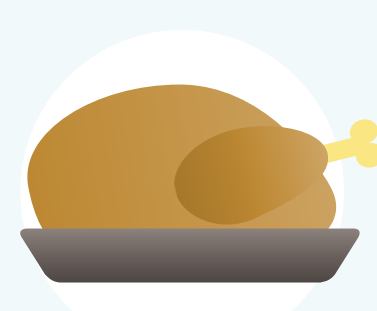


Charles Settlement House

MVP provided a portion of the **10,000** Thanksgiving meals at the community dinner.

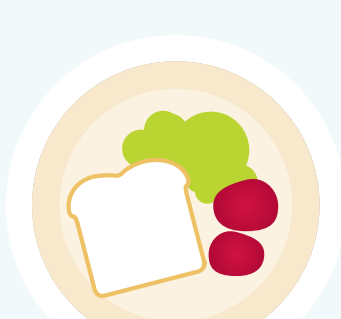


Foodlink
