

Payment Policy Updates: Services Not Reimbursed

MVP Health Care® (MVP) is consistent in following Medicare guidelines and Claims EXT edits for services that are not reimbursed distinctly and separately. Effective 9/1/2019, MVP will not reimburse separately for the services that fall under the categories listed below. These services are inclusive in other payments made by MVP. Services and CPT codes are included but not limited to:

Radiology Payment Policy – Effective 9/1/2019 Primary Care Physicians, Physician Assistants and Nurse Practitioners reading diagnostic images require an overread of the image by a Radiologist or a specialist physician reviewing the image within the scope of their specialty. Physician specialists are required to have the image overread by a radiologist if the imaging is outside the scope of their practice. MVP reimburses for only one reading of a diagnostic radiology test. Duplicate readings are not eligible for reimbursement.
