

Follow-Up After High-Intensity Care for Substance Use Disorder (FUI)

New measure effective 2020

Patient Profile

MVP members who are 13 years of age and older who were discharged from an acute inpatient hospitalization, residential treatment, or detoxification visit for a diagnosis of substance use disorder and who had a follow-up visit with any Provider for a principal diagnosis of substance use disorder within seven days or 30 days following the discharge or visit.

Measure Details

Follow-up appointments can be with any Provider. Telehealth visits, e-visits, and virtual check-ins can be used for both the 7- and 30-day follow-up visit. Follow-up visits on the same date as the discharge do not count for this measure.



How to Implement Best Practices and Improve Performance

Encourage staff to help coordinate assistance for Members with barriers to getting to their appointment, including childcare, transportation, and housing that might prevent them from attending treatment appointments.

Receiving timely information from hospitals can assist in faster follow-up. Consider utilizing your health information exchange (HIE) to gain more information on discharges or by working collaboratively with the most frequented hospital to obtain data exchange reports on your patients for better care coordination.

Maintain regular appointment availability for Members with recent discharges to ensure they can get an appointment in the designated time frame.

Evaluate your office procedure when a Member calls to cancel an appointment. Consider implementing a workflow that encourages staff to outreach to Members who cancel appointments and to reschedule as soon as possible.

Consider screening Members for a personal or family history of substance use.

When substance abuse is identified, schedule appropriate treatment, and explain the importance of follow-up to your patients.

Refer Member to an appropriate behavioral health provider as indicated.
