

Comprehensive Diabetes Care (CDC): Retinal Exam Using Funduscopy Photography

MVP members 18–75 years of age with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes who have a retinal or dilated eye exam performed in the current measurement year. The use of funduscopy cameras in primary care offices provides the opportunity to close retinal eye exam gaps in care for members who do not routinely see an eye care specialist.

Using the funduscopy cameras, primary care physicians can take images of patients' eyes, without dilation, and send them to an eye care specialist for review and interpretation.
