

## Diabetes Screening for People with Schizophrenia or Bipolar Disorder Who are Using Antipsychotic Medications (SSD)

### Patient Profile

MVP members 18–64 years of age with Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective Disorder, or Bipolar Disorder who were dispensed an antipsychotic medication and had a diabetes screening test during the measurement year.

Note: Members meeting for this measure do not have diabetes, but studies show that people diagnosed with Schizophrenia have an increase risk of developing diabetes.

### How to Implement Best Practices and Improve Performance

As a preventive measure, screen your patients for Diabetes annually (Glucose Test or HbA1c) and document the results.

- If the patient reports having had previous lab work, providers must obtain the official results; patient reporting is not valid for medical record entry.
- Educate patients about appropriate health screening with certain medication therapies.
- Make sure the medical record contains the contact information of all patient's current providers for possible future follow-up and care coordination.

#### Facts

- This measure excludes patients already diagnosed with Diabetes.
- There is a correlation between elevated blood sugars and weight gain when using antipsychotic medications. This is especially prevalent in patients with Schizophrenia and/or Bipolar Disorder.

#### Things to Consider

- Can the office electronic health record (EHR) be set up to flag for lab test based on diagnosis?
- Routinely arrange for the lab test either to be done in the office during the patient's visit or schedule lab testing before the patient leaves office.
